

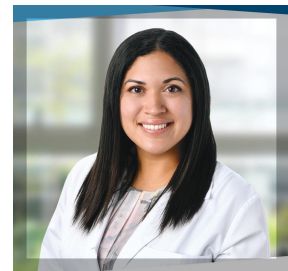

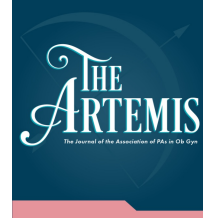

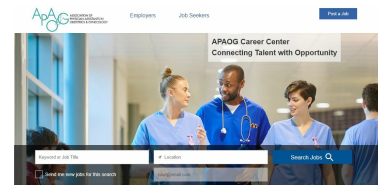
2022 Virtual Conference - On Demand Recordings
